By calling this number, a Pfizer First Resource® Program counselor can offer help with your XALKORI® (crizotinib) prescription.

If you're insured, you'll be advised of specialty pharmacies for filling your prescription.

If you are uninsured or don't have enough coverage, the First Resource counselor can help you verify if you are eligible to get XALKORI for free through our patient assistance program.

Filling your prescription

XALKORI is available only at certain specialty pharmacies. These pharmacies often handle medicines that aren't kept on hand at regular neighborhood pharmacies.

When you call, the First Resource counselor will ask you a few basic questions, including your insurance information. That way they will help you find the most appropriate specialty pharmacies for your insurance.

Co-pay assistance*

There is a co-pay assistance program for XALKORI prescriptions. This offer helps insured, eligible patients pay no more than \$100 for each prescription, with an annual maximum savings of \$24,000. There are certain financial and other restrictions.* Call 1.855.XALKORI (1.855.925.5674) for co-pay enrollment, Monday-Friday 9am-5pm ET. Please be sure to ask if you qualify.

Additional patient assistance

If you are uninsured or don't qualify for the co-pay assistance program, a First Resource counselor can help research and find what programs you may be eligible for to get XALKORI. Pfizer is committed to helping people get the Pfizer medicine they need.

Terms and Conditions for Co-pay Program

By enrolling in the XALKORI® (crizotinib) co-pay offer, you acknowledge that you currently meet the eligibility criteria and will comply with the terms and conditions described below:

1. The offer is not valid for prescriptions that are eligible to be reimbursed, in whole or in part, by Medicaid, Medicare, or other federal or state healthcare programs (including any state prescription drug assistance programs and the Government Health Insurance Plan available in Puerto Rico [formerly known as “La Reforma de Salud”]).
2. The offer is not valid for prescriptions that are eligible to be reimbursed by private insurance plans or other health or pharmacy benefit programs which reimburse you for the entire cost of your prescription drugs.
3. You will pay no more than \$100 of your co-pay on each prescription for up to a maximum annual savings of \$24,000.
4. You must deduct the value received under this program from any reimbursement request submitted to your insurance plan, either directly by you or on your behalf.
5. The offer is not valid for Massachusetts residents whose prescriptions are covered in whole or in part by third-party insurance, or where otherwise prohibited by law.
6. Cannot be combined with any other rebate/coupon, free trial, or similar offer for the specified prescription.
7. **The offer will be accepted only at participating pharmacies.**
8. **This offer is not health insurance.**
9. Offer good only in the U.S. and Puerto Rico.
10. Pfizer reserves the right to rescind, revoke, or amend the program without notice.
11. Program expires 12/31/2012.
